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We had a visit from King's College Hospital oral health team this week. They talked to the children about the importance of brushing their teeth and which foods are healthy and unhealthy for oral health. On Wednesday we took the children to 'The Nest' to meet Mrs Van der Berg and take part in her sensory play sessions for the first time! After a warm up session with listening and action songs, the children explored different 'touch and texture' based activities. We ended with bubbles and a calm down session. Next Wednesday, the theme will be colours.

We have also been talking a lot about colours in our carpet times. We have listened to songs about colours and read the story 'Cat's Colours'. We particularly enjoyed this song

We will continue to learn about colours next week and will use the story 'Brown Bear, Brown Bear What do you See?' as a focus for this.

The children also enjoyed learning 'Five Little Monkeys Swinging in a Tree'. **We have uploaded this as an activity on Tapestry**, so you can have fun singing it with your child. It's a great way of using fingers to count up to five and then count down again as the monkeys get 'snapped'!

We are continuing to encourage the children's independence - for example, having a go at putting on their own coats. This is how we teach the children to put on their coats.
