The spelling pattern this week is common exception words.

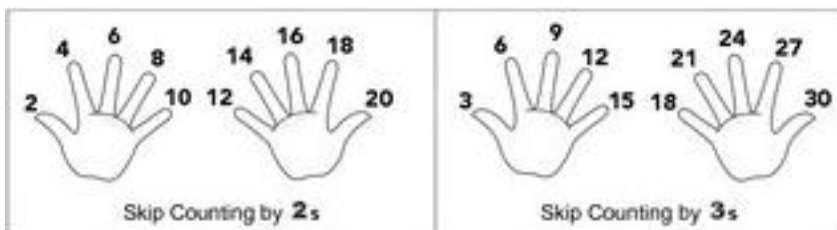

In English we will be completing our learning linked to 'The Journey Home' by writing a persuasive museum sign explaining why an endangered animal should be saved. We will then be beginning our work linked to a new story, 'Dear Earth'. We will be thinking about using 'would' in sentences describing places we would like to explore and will be writing instructions using command sentences for an explorer's club. In maths, we are continuing our learning about multiplication, looking at the 2, 5 and 10 times tables. In R.E, we are learning about how Christians represent Jesus as 'The Light of the World' and in science, we will be carrying out an experiment. In geography, we will be locating the equator on a world map and learning about what it is like there.

Homework

This week, you could help your child by looking for examples of instructions at home, e.g. rules for a board game, a recipe for cooking, instructions to build something. Talk to your child about how instructions often start with a verb, e.g. Mix the ingredients. Encourage your child to make a list of the verbs they find in their instructions.
