This week in English, we will be continuing our learning inspired by the book, 'Dear Earth'. We will be researching about sea turtles and using what we have found out to write factual sentences. In maths, we are learning about multiplication using the 3 times table, then using our knowledge of the 2, 3, 5 and 10 times tables to solve word problems. 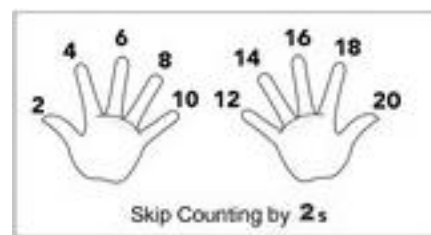
Homework
